SIGNED AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF BELGRADE

In the Old Palace, which houses the City Assembly of Belgrade, on 11 December, an Agreement with the City of Belgrade for 2016 was signed. Deputy Mayor of the City of Belgrade, Andrija Mladenović, and "LUKOIL SRBIJA" AD CEO, Andrey Kuku, made this cooperation for 2016 public.

By signing this Agreement, with the aim of expanding and developing cooperation on a long-term and stable basis, "LUKOIL SRBIJA" will finance in the year to come projects in the field of culture, science, sports, environment, as well as social and humanitarian projects.
