AWARDS GIVEN ON THE OCCASION OF VICTORY DAY

At a festive ceremony on the occasion of 70th Anniversary of Victory in the Great Patriotic War, held in Moscow today, LUKOIL employees received decorations from the Russian government, its agencies and from their own company.
