COOPERATION WITH THE CITY OF BELGRADE-FINAL WORKS ON THE
GREAT HALL AT THE CHILDREN'S CENTER

Goran Vesić, the City Manager and Vesna Ružičić, the Sales Manager at "LUKOIL SRBIJA" AD, toured the Great Hall at the Children's Cultural Center in Belgrade where finishing works are under way on its renovation.
