LUKOIL SRBIJA AWARDS GIVEN TO THE CONTEST WINNERS

The Belgrade Faculty of Economics was the place where on 21 May awards and diplomas to to the students, winners of the Contest on the topic: "Oil Company "LUKOIL SRBIJA" AD as Regional Centre of Serbia, Macedonia, Montenegro and Croatia - the Potential and Risks", implemented in cooperation with "LUKOIL SRBIJA" AD, were given.

Your participation in these contests testifies to your role in active learning and your personality as well. I am convinced that these awards will help you and be useful in your future studies, maybe even your future employment," the Senior Human Resources and Administrative Manager, Alexei Grigoriev, said on the occasion of diploma handing over.

The Contest was open from 11 April to 11 May of this year, and students of Basic Academic Studies and Master Studies of the Faculty of Economics were entitled to participate.
