LUKOIL SERBIA SUPPORTED HUMANITARIAN PROGRAM "SOUNDS OF THE HEART"

With the financial support of LUKOIL SERBIA, the humanitarian organization "Dečje srce" implemented an education program in the period from July 10 to 30 this year, in the field of job training for persons with developmental disabilities. The program was carried out within the work center "Sounds of the Heart" in Belgrade in accordance with the Law on Professional Rehabilitation and Employment of Persons with Disabilities of the Republic of Serbia.

The training included two modules. The first module was focused on the acquiring social skills and competencies, such as respecting the daily rhythm, business dress code, hygiene, and communication. These skills were trained through the simulation of working conditions in the cafe, workshop and store that exist within the "Heart Sounds" work center. The second module was aimed at acquiring specific work skills needed to perform jobs such as bartender, waiter, salesperson, working on a press and working on a sewing machine. The participants were divided into two groups, and each participant was approached individually, in order to achieve better results.

The director of the organization "Dečje srce" Goran Rojević thanked the company LUKOIL SERBIA for the support of this unique project, pointing out that in the next three months, all participants of the training will practice what they have learned in the work center "Sounds of the heart" and will prepare for a more independent life and work engagement in the environment in which they live.
