DONATION TO THE PARAPLEGIC ASSOCIATION OF ZLATIBOR DISTRICT

The donation of RSD 246,000 made by "LUKOIL SERBIA" in favour of the Paraplegic Association of Zlatibor District in the Municipality of Užice was presented by Ana Janković, the Director of Human Resources & Administration. The donation provided for the procurement of a significant quantity of spare parts for aids used by the Association members, including aid accessories, sanitary devices and medical and sanitary supplies. The Mayor, Tihomir Petković, expressed his appreciation to the Company on behalf of the City of Užice, emphasizing that Užice was among the first Serbian cities to establish the Office for Economic Cooperation with the Russian Federation that initiated the cooperation with "LUKOIL SRBIJA" A.D. "We have embraced a good concept of financing the activities of this Office through public work, jointly with the National Employment Agency. At the time of its foundation, we declared that our objective would be to build the political and economic cooperation between the two states, between the city of Užice and the cities of the Russian Federation.
